

HDFC Bank has won Dun & Bradstreet Corporate Award 2017 in the Banking sector. The 11th edition of the Dun & Bradstreet Corporate Awards was held in Mumbai. Methodology: How winners are chosen?

Dun & Bradstreet India has developed a proprietary financial model for identifying the top companies in each sector. An awards methodology is applied to this list of top 500 companies, duly classified in their respective sectors. The parameters considered for ranking the companies include total income, net profit, net worth, net profit margin, return on net worth, and average market capitalization, among others. Winners are then chosen on bases of a composite score of these weighted parameters. The companies are short listed on the basis of their market capitalisation on the Bombay Stock Exchange and the National Stock Exchange, India's two main stock exchanges.
